

Graduate School of Banking at Colorado **2018 WSSB Scholarship/Grant Information**



The top achieving graduating senior is chosen each year to receive a scholarship/grant from the Graduate School of Banking at Colorado (GSBC). The scholarship recipient must attend a session in Boulder, Colorado, by the following summer (i.e. a 2018 graduating recipient has to attend by July 2019). GSBC's on-campus session is a two-week program.

1. The WSSB/GSBC partnership allows all WSSB graduates to enter into the GSBC program as "Second-Year Direct" students, where two vs. three years are required to complete the program.
2. The GSBC scholarship award to one WSSB student has to be redeemed by attending a summer session following WSSB's graduation (within a year), however, he or she may attend the whole three-year program, if preferred.
3. The scholarship is \$1,360 per year, for up to three years of attendance, but a WSSB graduate may attend as a second-year direct student for only two years.

2018 tuition and fees to attend GSBC include a \$300 non-refundable processing fee plus \$4,075 tuition (which includes meals, materials, and on-campus housing) for a total of \$4,375.

Deducting the GSBC scholarship award of \$1,360, a WSSB recipient's costs are \$3,015 per year, not including travel and graduation fees.
