FLC Accommodations & Parking

Campus Accommodations: WSSB students are required to stay on campus in student dorms, paid for in the enrollment fee. Two to three WSSB students may stay in each quad suite at the [Animas Hall \(Residence Hall\)](#), and roommate requests can be made of the same gender.

Animas Hall is Fort Lewis' newest residence hall, designed with the environment in mind. It is LEED Gold Certified for its sustainable features and design.

Animas Hall Front Desk

Located in the lobby of Animas Hall, this station serves as the FLC Conference Front Desk during the summer, and is where students check in to their rooms. It is staffed from 8:00 am to 10:00 pm daily, with a 24/7 after-hours number: (970) 247-6554.

There is no daily housekeeping in the suites or exchange of these items. If you want fresh items (sheets, towels, soap, etc.) it is recommended that you bring your own supply.

The following are provided in each suite:

- ✧ Bedrooms: each quad has four bedrooms, each furnished with an extra-long twin bed, desk, chair, and wardrobe. Each WSSB students will be provided:
 - Pillow and blanket
 - Top Sheet and fitted sheet
 - Towel, hand towel, wash cloth
 - Soap and plastic cup
- ✧ Bathroom:
 - Two sinks
 - Separate shower room
 - Separate toilet room
 - Shower curtains
 - Trash cans, Bath Mat
- ✧ Living Room:
 - Flat Screen TV
 - Furniture
 - Microwave, mini-fridge, and a flat-screen TV (with over 70 channels);
 - Ethernet ports and wireless internet access (see information below for guest Wi-Fi access);
 - Blinds

Directions to FLC Campus and Animas Hall from Downtown Durango

Main Avenue in Durango is only three miles long from the north to the south end of town. Many of Durango's Five-Star restaurants are located in "*Rio Grande Land*," the eight-block area north of the train station on Main Avenue.

Signage on College (8th Street) points to campus, and you'll go east from Main, eight blocks to 8th Avenue and turn left. Follow 8th Avenue up this serpentine, winding street to the top of the hill (approximately 1 mile) the only campus stoplight. Proceed through and Animas Hall is immediately on your right, with parking right outside the building in the Centennial Lot. Parking is free on campus during the summer, so no worries about any "Permit required" signs.
